

ORDINANCE NO. 6

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROMOTING THE SAFETY, ORDER AND GENERAL WELFARE OF THE PUBLIC BY RESTRICTING THE USE OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE TOWN

THE TOWN BOARD OF NEWPORT, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. NO PERSON EXCEPT A DULY APPOINTED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WHILE ENGAGED IN HIS OFFICIAL DUTIES SHALL DISCHARGE A FIREARM, AIR GUN OR ANY OTHER WEAPON USING A SINGLE SLUG AT ANY TIME WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWNSHIP.

SECTION II. ANY PERSON VIOLATING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE PUNISHED BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) OR BY IMPRISONMENT IN THE COUNTY JAIL FOR NOT MORE THAN THIRTY (30) DAYS.

SECTION III. THE ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION.
