ORDINANCE NO. 32

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT UNAUTHORIZED ENTRY UPON PRIVATE PROPERTY BY PERSON OR VEHICLE, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES.

The Town Board of Grey Cloud Township, Washington County, Minnesota, does hereby ordain:

No person shall enter upon or drive any vehicle upon any land owned or occupied by another without written permission from the owner or legal occupant of such land.

This section shall not apply:

- 1. To persons in the immediate presence of, and with the consent of the owner or occupant of such land.
- 2. To persons upon the primary accepted driveway while entering or leaving to carry out a lawful purpose with the owner or occupant of such land.
- 3. To persons upon the Town Hall property or upon the ball field immediately adjacent to the Town Hall property.

Any person violating this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be subject to fine or imprisonment as set forth in Minnesota Statutes 609.02, Subd. 3, and as said statute may from time to time be amended.
